
I am writing on behalf of Zahid Chaudhry, who is a decorated United States Army Veteran, honorably discharged from his military service. Mr. Chaudhry became disabled while in the military and has continued to serve his community in many ways despite his disabilities.

Mr. Chaudhry has been married to a U.S. citizen for over 16 years. He resides with his wife and children in Olympia. He has been trying to obtain citizenship for the past 15 years. He came to this country legally from Pakistan and has broken no laws.

There is no reason that Mr. Chaudhry should be deported. He served this country, received medals such as the Reserve Achievement Medal, National Defense Service Medal, Global War on Terrorism Service Medal, among others, and should be eligible for citizenship through the Qualified Military Service.
